

New Volunteer at the Club?

If you are a new volunteer, and have been advised by the club that you require a blue card, you need to complete a Volunteer blue card application form which can be accessed from the Commission's website at:

Please complete section B in full, then have an authorised club member complete the club's details in section A. The authorised club member must also verify your identification and sign the application on behalf of the club in section D. To have your identification documents verified, you need to take two forms of identification that show your signature, full name and date of birth. For example, a current Drivers licence and a Medicare card.

To avoid unnecessary delays, check your application form has been completed in full. Remember, you can't start volunteering until you have been issued with a blue card.

Continuing Volunteering at the Club?

A blue card is valid for two years. If you already have a blue card, check the expiry date to ensure it is still current. If the expiry date on your card is approaching, an application to renew the card can be made 30 days prior to the cards expiry.

If you lodge your renewal application at least 30 days prior to the expiry date of the card, you may continue to volunteer, even if you have not received your new blue card, provided your current blue card has not been suspended or cancelled.
